In the pending court case of Nuñez Escobar, et al. v. Gaines, et al., Case No. 3:11-cv-994, in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Tennessee, the plaintiffs, represented by Ozment Law, the ACLU Immigrants' Rights Project, the ACLU of Tennessee, and Hughes Socol Piers Resnick & Dym, Ltd., and the non-governmental, private defendants in the case have reached a settlement with no admission of wrongdoing that provides a conclusion to a very long legal process while allowing these parties to avoid the time and expense of a trial. The private defendants paid an undisclosed amount as part of the settlement, and the lawsuit has been dismissed as to those defendants.
