Per Curiam:

On February 14, 2013, Petitioners filed a writ of mandamus in the joint military commission trial of Khalid Shaikh Mohammad, Walid Muhammad Salih Mubarek Bin 'Attash, Ramzi Binalshibh, Ali Abdul Aziz Ali, and Mustafa Ahmed Adam al Hawsawi (*United States v. Mohammad et al*) at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.

On February 25, 2013, one of five accused in the military commission case of *United States v. Mohammad et al*, Ali Abdul Aziz Ali, also known as Ammar al Baluchi, and the sole accused in the military commission case of *United States v. al Nashiri*, each filed a motion for leave to intervene in Case No. 13-002.

¹ Al Baluchi and al Nashiri also filed similar motions to intervene in Case No. 13-003.

On March 4, 2013, Respondent objected to the motions to intervene.

On March 7, 2013, al Baluchi and al Nashiri filed motions to file reply briefs in support of motions for leave to intervene.

On March 8, 2013, al Baluchi filed a motion to file a supplemental appendix.

ORDER

Upon consideration of the motions and motions to reply filed by the Intervenors, including Respondent's brief in opposition, as well as Petitioners and Respondent's briefs and Petitioners' reply brief on the merits, as well as the appendix filed by Respondent, and the supplemental appendix filed by Intervenors, it is

ORDERED the motions to intervene filed by al Baluchi and al Nashiri are **DENIED**.
